

Arts and Crafts Contest

Rules

A. Eligibility

The Arts and Crafts Contest is open to anyone who is registered at an NFR Convention.

Any kind of article may be entered provided:

1. It is the sole work of the entrant
2. The entrant personally brings the article to the contest room, ie entry by proxy is not allowed
3. The entry has not won any First Place or Best of Show at a previous NFR Contest
4. The entrant completes and submits an Arts and Crafts Entry Form and an Arts and Crafts Judges' Score Sheet with the entry.

B. Categories

1. Sewing - items made by hand or with a machine
2. Pinwork - includes Knitting, crocheting, etc.
3. Needlework - includes embroidery, needlepoint, bunka, etc
4. Other - all other crafts not mentioned above eg. woodworking, stained glass, etc

C. Judging

Points are awarded in the following categories and listed on the Arts and Crafts Judges Score Sheet:

1. Construction & Materials
2. Complexity
3. Finishing & Display
4. Neatness

D. Awards

1. Plaques shall be awarded for first place in each category.
2. Best of Show is awarded to the entry considered Best of Show by the Contest Judges.
